


## HK MP5 TWO-STAGE TRIGGER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**











- NOTE: The MP5 Timney Trigger fits both Pistol Caliber and Rifle versions. Pistol Calibers have one locking pin, while Rifle versions have two locking pins.
- Remove magazine from firearm and double check to ensure the chamber is empty.
- Remove the stock by removing the locking pins, then pivot out the pistol grip.
- Cock the hammer and rotate the safety to the 12 o'clock position, at this point you can remove the safety. Once the safety has been removed, remove the stock trigger unit.
- To release the ejector from the stock trigger housing, push down on the front ejector pin and set aside.

- Remove the ejector and the spring from the stock trigger housing.
- 6 Reinstall the ejector and spring into your new Timney Trigger by following step 4 in reverse

A. Once ejector has been installed, ensure it moves freely and does not bind.

- To install your new Timney Trigger, you must ensure the hammer is cocked to allow the safety to be inserted. Once the safety is inserted replace it to the "safe" position.
- Reinstall the pistol grip into the stock, and reassemble the stock.
- You are now ready to enjoy your new Timney Trigger!
