
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

870 TRIGGERFIX

Before beginning work on any firearm, remove the ammunition source and double check to insure the chamber is empty.






STEP 1: Make sure the action is cocked - Work pump and engage safety.


STEP 2: Remove two receiver pins and trigger housing. (Figure 2)

STEP 3: Remove the trigger plate bushing by pushing it right to left. (Figure 3)


STEP 4: Remove spring from sear. (Figure 4)







STEP 5: With pressure on the carrier dog (Figure 5), remove the carrier pivot tube by pushing it left to right. (Figure 6) Then remove the carrier assembly. STEP 6: Remove the carrier dog follower - spring and plunger. (Figure 7)









STEP 7: Using a flat tip screw driver, move the connector over and then below the action bar clearing the sear pin for removal. (Figures 8-10)







STEP 8: Remove the sear pin by pushing it from right to left. (Figure 11)

STEP 10: Remove factory sear and install new sear with sear pin.

STEP 11: Install new sear spring. Three springs are provided; Blue = light pull weight, White = medium pull weight Red = heavy pull weight.

STEP 12: Move the connector back to original position above the action bar (See figure 8) and reinstall the carrier dog assembly. (See figures 5-7) STEP 13: Install trigger plate bushing (See figure 3) and install the trigger housing back into the receiver with two pins. (See figure 2).

STEP 14: Conduct a functions check verifying that the pump locks forward, that the slide release works, that the safety works, that the gun will fire and that the gun re-cocks when the pump is cycled.

To adjust trigger pull weight, remove the trigger assembly and swap sear springs. You can also fine-tune the pull weight by using the supplied wrench to turn the set screw on the sear no more than four turns. Four

turns will allow about 1 pound of adjustment. (Figure 13)
